In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 8981 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The overall purpose of project consists in providing the required services to furnish and apply an emulsified asphalt surface treatment (FAA Specification P-608) to the runway of Fernando Ribas Dominicci (SIG) Airport in Isla Grande, PR. Project also includes repairs different areas on the runway. Other associated work includes: pavement marking, clearing and grubbing, etc., all, in accordance to plans and specifications.


Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until **June 7, 2018 at 10:00 AM**. A pre-bid conference will be held at **10:00 AM (PR Time) on May 23, 2018** at the Puerto Rico Port Authority Engineering Conference Room, PRPA Engineering Building, 2nd floor, Lindbergh Street, Isla Grande, PR. PRPA strongly encourages prospective bidders to attend the pre-bid conference. The Drawings, Specifications and other contract documents for this project can be obtained at the Engineering Bureau Building of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office, Phone Number (787) 729-8715 extension 3178/3184/3182/2266/2348, until 48 hours prior to the bid opening by paying a non-refundable amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Board of Awards at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR, at the same day of the Bid Opening of each project.

The project is conditioned upon the receipt of federal funding under provisions of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP). Certain mandatory federal requirements apply to this solicitation and will be made part of any contract awarded. The Qualified Bidder must comply with all federal regulations, including, but not limited, to Access to Records and Reports (Reference: 2 CFR § 200.326, 2 CFR § 200.333), affirmative action requirement (Reference: 41 CFR part 60-4, Executive Order 11246), Breach of Contract Terms.
