



Judge Brian K. Tester received his law degree from Pepperdine University School of Law in Los Angeles, California. He relocated to Puerto Rico in 1993 where he worked for a chapter 7 trustee, a chapter 11 bankruptcy firm, the Office of the U.S. Trustee, and the largest/oldest San Juan law firm.
