The Executive Director of FAFAA acts as liaison between the Government of Puerto Rico and the Financial Oversight and Management Board and is also responsible for overseeing compliance with the budget certified, and the fiscal plan approved, pursuant to the Puerto Rico Oversight, Management and Economic Stability Act of 2016. As Fiscal Agent, he is also responsible for public debt restructuring and renegotiation.
