
In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 7496 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The work on this project consists of maintenance dredging of the entrance channel and the berthing areas of the Fajardo Ferry Terminal Harbor. Scope of works includes but is not limited to perform the maintenance dredging of approximately 13,000 cubic yards of dredging material. The dredged material must be deposited in an adjacent upland site, selected by contractor, all in accordance with regulations, drawings and technical specifications.

Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until **October 27, 2016 at 9:30 AM**. A non-compulsory pre-bid conference will be held on **October 18, 2016 at 10:00 AM (PR Time)** at the Puerto Rico Port Authority Engineering Conference Room, PRPA Engineering Building, 2nd floor, Lindbergh Street, Isla Grande, PR. The Drawings, Specifications and other contract documents for this project can be obtained at the Engineering Bureau Building of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office, Phone Number (787) 729-8715 extension 3219/3182, until October 24, 2016 by paying a non refundable amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Board of Awards at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR, at the same day of the Bid Opening.

The successful bidder must submit to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority the required bonds, insurance, policies, certificate of having filed an income tax return statement to the Puerto Rico Treasury Department for the last five years, certificate of debts to the Government of Puerto Rico, certificate of payment of property taxes (CRIM), certificate of payment of unemployment insurance, temporal incapacity and social security for drivers, etc., and shall execute the construction contract within ten (10) working days after the date of the Notice of Award.
