**CULEBRA FERRY TERMINAL IMPROVEMENTS

In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 7496 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

Project "CULEBRA FERRY TERMINAL IMPROVEMENTS" consists of the rehabilitation of the Cargo Ramp, including new passenger access walkways. The area between the cargo ramp and the terminal building will be modified to be part of the waiting area. Minor architectural improvements will also be made in the terminal building, including the construction of a mooring dolphin, which will allow docking of large capacity vessels. All works shall be in accordance with the contract documents and technical specifications.

Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until July 6, 2017 at 9:30 A.M. (PR Time). A compulsory pre-bid conference will be held at 1:30 P.M (PR Time) on June 15, 2017 at the Conference Room of the Engineering Bureau Building at Isla Grande, San Juan, P.R.

The Drawings, Specifications and other contract documents for this project, on electronic format, can be obtained at the Engineering Bureau Building of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office, from the date of the pre-bid meeting, Phone Number (787) 729-8715 extension 3184/3182/3178, until five calendar days prior to the bid opening by paying a nonrefundable amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Bids Board at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR, at the same day of the Bid Opening of each project.

The project is conditioned upon the receipt of federal funding under provisions of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Certain mandatory federal requirements apply to this solicitation and will be made part of any contract awarded.

The successful bidder must submit to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority the required contract documents within ten (10) working days after the date of the Notice of Award.
