Julie Anglin serves as Colombia Desk Officer in the Market Access and Compliance (MAC) division of the U.S. Department of Commerce in Washington, DC. In this capacity, Ms. Anglin helps U.S. companies address various market barriers and commercial irritants they encounter while doing business in Colombia. Ms. Anglin has played a key role in the development and promotion of the U.S.-Colombia Free Trade Agreement, which took effect on May 15, 2012.

During her decade of service to the Commerce Department, Ms. Anglin has performed public outreach across the country to highlight U.S. trade policy initiatives such as CAFTA-DR, bilateral agreements with Colombia, Peru, and Panama, and the Andean Trade Preferences Act (ATPA).

In 2009, Ms. Anglin was named a Brookings Institution Legislative Fellow and served as a foreign affairs and trade advisor to Congressman Greg Meeks (D-NY).

From 1999-2000, Ms. Anglin served as a Trade Specialist at the Kentucky World Trade Center in Lexington, a non-profit organization helping Kentucky companies to import, export, and establish overseas operations.

A native of Grayson, Kentucky, Ms. Anglin graduated summa cum laude from the University of Kentucky with a dual B.A. in History and Classics. She earned a M.A. from the Patterson School of Diplomacy and International Commerce at the University of Kentucky.
