- Primary Healthcare Centers (FQHC) in Puerto Rico have been able to work towards 11 out of 15 components within the 3 dimensions of this initiative from NACHC and HRSA.

- Actual framework uses several approach towards value-based care including but not limited to: (1) <u>Patient</u>
 <u>Centered Medical Home standards</u>, (2) <u>High-Cost High Need quality framework</u>, (3) <u>Performance Measures</u>
