

EARLY ADOPTERS



- Adapt or become irrelevant, Netflix embraced digital while Blockbuster went out of business
- In 2006, major retail brands (Sears, JCPenney, Macy's, etc.)
 valued more than Amazon

DIGITAL INTERACTIONS



- Zoom reported higher sales and profit from May through July than it did in all of 2019
- Many are surprised by how quickly and effectively technologies were adopted. For many, the results have been better than imagined

THE NEXT NORMAL



- Changing attitudes on the role of the office (80% enjoy working from home)
- Access new talent with fewer locational constraints while being able to adopt innovative processes to boost productivity
