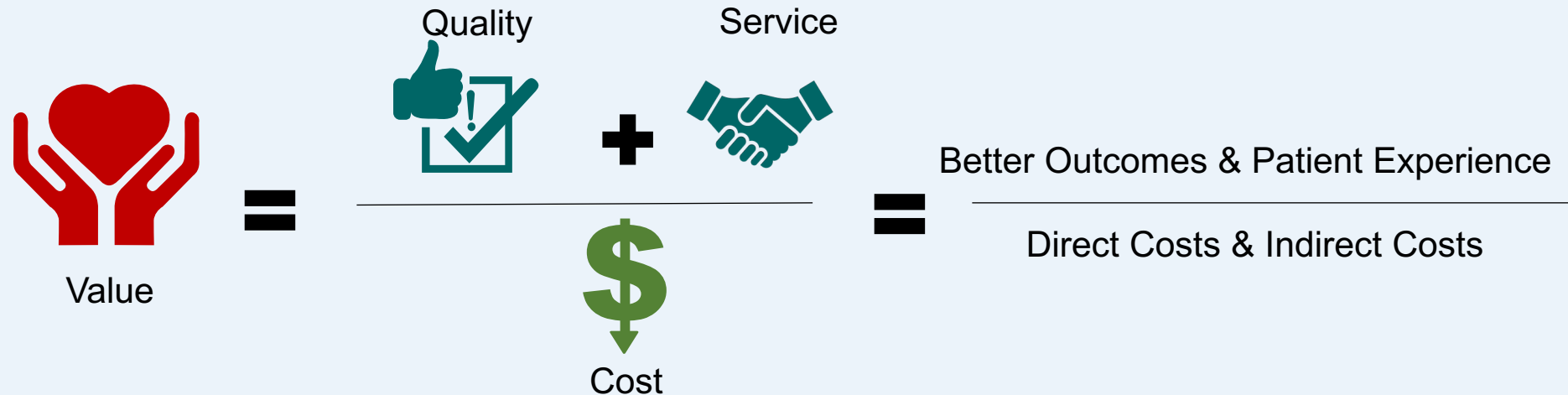

## Why is it important?

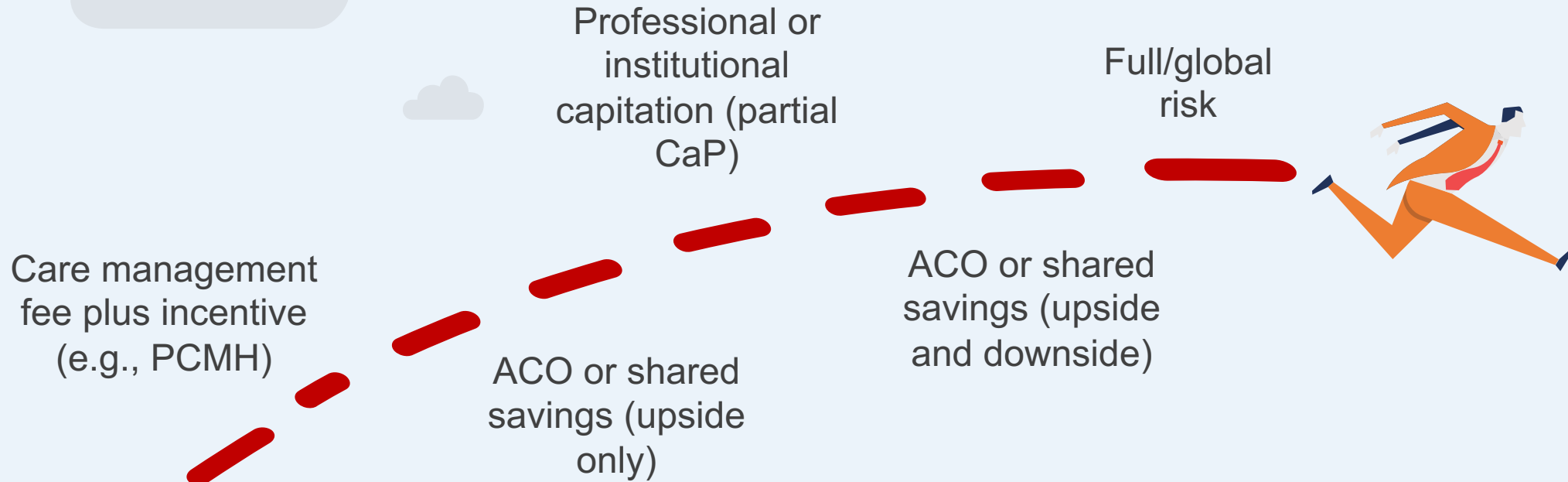
- Patient care becomes coordinated.

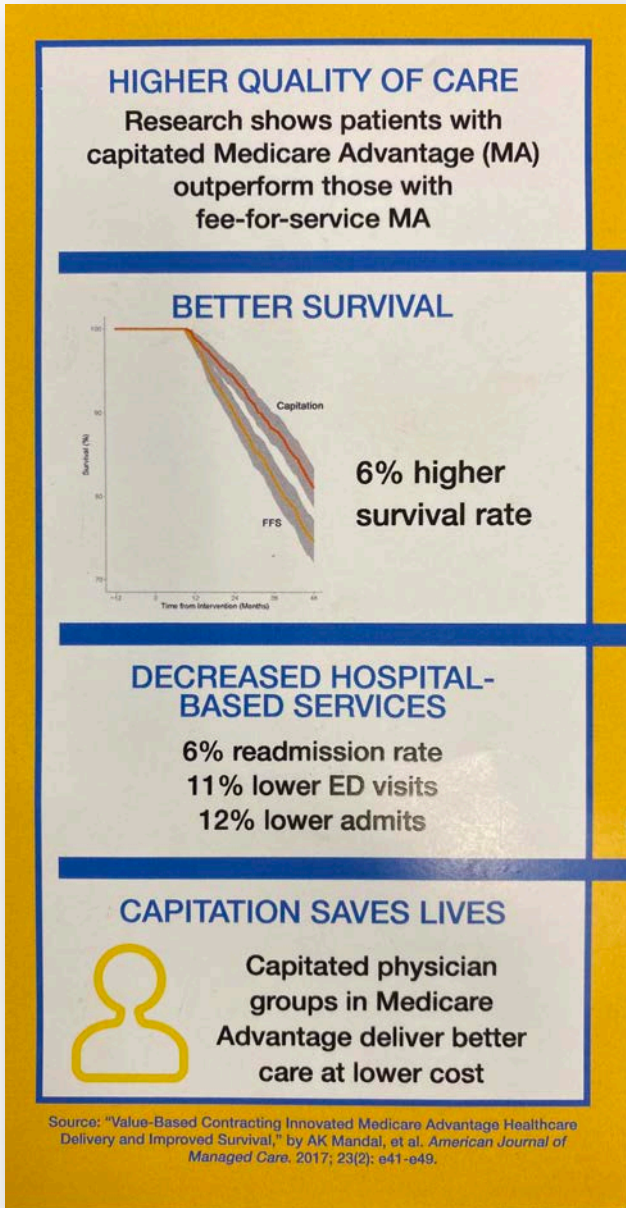
