



Orange County Property Appraiser Amy Mercado is the first Latina (Puertorriqueña) in the State of Florida to be elected as a Property Appraiser.

Prior to serving as the Property Appraiser, Amy made history when she and her father were elected the first Democratic, father/daughter, Latinx, duo to serve in the Florida Legislature. Amy as a State House Representative for House District 48 (2016-2020); and her father as a State Senator for Senate District 15.

While serving in the legislature Amy was also the Director of Operations for the National Mango Board, a national commodity board overseen by USDA. Her responsibilities included the management of a multi-million-dollar budget, reputation and crisis management, organizational leadership, vendor procurement, compliance, and human resources.

Amy was born and raised in the Bronx, New York; she has called Orange County home since 1996.

Amy earned her Executive MBA from the Jack Welch Management Institute at Strayer University, and a bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Management from American Intercontinental University.
