Melinda K. Woods is an executive leader in multiple growth stage technology and lifestyle organizations. As CEO and founder of Excellence-as-a-Service (EaaS) Consulting, Melinda cultivates business pathways, technology solutions, operational models for emerging technology, digital transformation strategy for companies. Melinda leverages extensive technology and business expertise to propel companies through start up and growth stages overseeing business structure, development, and production of new capabilities. technology. Additionally, Melinda held several positions at the Defense Intelligence Agency, including managing a team of analysts while deployed during Operation Iraqi Freedom where she received the civilian commendation award.

Prior to nearly 14 years of public sector roles, Melinda managed product R&D, reliability, and quality teams in the commercial semiconductor and telecommunications sectors at Motorola and Freescale Semiconductor. Melinda was competitively selected as a fellow for Intel Corporation, Nortel Networks in Paris, France, and Motorola Semiconductor Product Sector early in her career where she quickly advanced to earn accolades and top performer designations. Melinda holds bachelor's and master's degrees with academic distinctions in electrical engineering from the University of Michigan and the Georgia Institute of Technology, respectively, and an MBA from the University of Virginia Darden School of Business.
