




Minimum Wage Increase

If Minimum wage is increased to \$8.50


30% of Businesses either reduces workforce or work hours

If minimum wage goes to \$10


Heavy impact to workforce

Almost half of business owners can't fill jobs at current or even higher pay scales



Scarcity of workers, biggest jump in Business Owners problems


% Business reporting scarcity of workers as a major challenge

Scarcity of workers in businesses over 20 employees




But things are improving for the consumer

Personal finances change Oct vs. April




Consumers in savings mode or inflation worried?

Business Traffic coming back


All Retailer Formats experienced higher customer visits

Covid spread has been contained Less than 1.4% jump in 6 months



Business leaders want a larger workforce, but are not getting it


Within the next 6 months, your company will increase, same, reduce its workforce?



Businesses are ready to hire


Increased leves of traffic will lead to new hires

Within the next 6 months, your company will increase, same, reduce its workforce?




As vaccination goes up, also expansions

% of businesses with expansions in the works




Business Confidence is coming back
